

BADJA STATION

Gindalbie Metals Ltd (ASX: GBG) ('Gindalbie') has nominated part of Badja Station as a candidate site for a proposed national radioactive waste management facility to safely store Australia's intermediate level waste and dispose of low level waste created largely as a result of medical and other scientific procedures.

The call for voluntary land nominations was made by the Department of Industry and Science under the *Radioactive Waste Management Act 2012*. The search for a suitable site is a nationwide process which is subject to a transparent and rigorous technical, economic, social and environmental assessment. The volunteer site nomination phase is the first of four project phases in this process.

Badja Station is a destocked pastoral lease of 113,600 hectares located some 280kms east of Geraldton in the Shire of Yalgoo.

Prior to submitting its nomination, Gindalbie completed a programme of preliminary engagement and consultations with representatives of local communities and stakeholders.

Extensive public consultations will continue to be undertaken during every stage of the project. Gindalbie looks forward to working with all stakeholders in an endeavour to bring further substantial economic development to the Mid West region.
